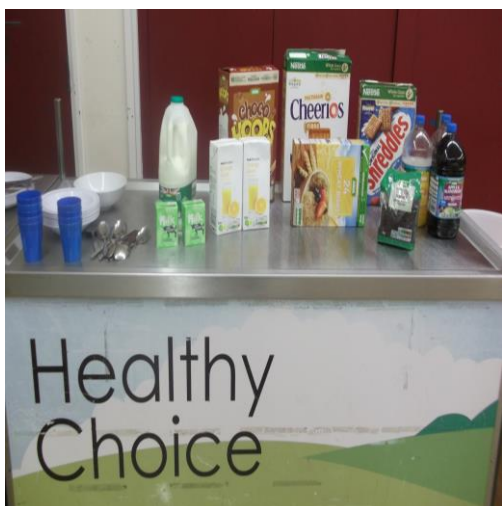
Breakfast is served until 8.15am every morning with a variety of options on offer:

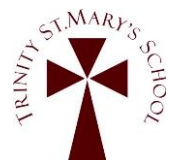
"I enjoy playing games with my friends before I start school." Sophia, Year 3
